St. Thomas Aquinas Ski Club Consent Form

- All participants in skiing and snowboarding activities (including supervisors) must wear a C.S.A. approved helmet. (You can rent one from Canyon Resort for \$5.00 per trip, GST included). Helmets are included if you are renting.
